## Treasurer's Report

### 2022 Expenses Year to Date

1. Trash fees increased and they added an additional surcharge for fuel. Richard Higgens pointed out that the landfill closed, which likely also affected the cost.
2. Board opted to offset 2021 expenses by canceling volunteer EOY gifts (500 saving)

### 2023 Projected Budget

1. In 2021 we paid for the pool grinder pump and parking lot repair – under budget.
2. Besides above increases, having the phone connected all year will increase Pool budget (further explained under Pool Committee Report below)
3. Board decided that due to current funds and budget, HOA fees will remain fixed for 2023

We cannot upgrade the gate unless we get internet access at the pool – which we can explore in the future.
