BOARD NEWS

- The Board has received several complaints about homeowners not adhering to the Covenant Assurance Policy (CAP) regarding vehicle parking. Reminders: 1) homeowners should not block sidewalks and should avoid overnight street parking, 2) overnight driveway parking is only permitted after at least two vehicles are parked in the garage (assuming 3-car garage). There appear to be a few homeowners who are either unaware of these requirements or don't care. As noted on previous occasions, the Board does not wish to be a "Big Brother", but consistent violations are subject to a \$50 per month fine.
- We have also received homeowner and postal carrier complaints regarding mailboxes being blocked by vehicles. In addition to being discourteous to neighbors, repeatedly blocked mailboxes can result in the USPS skipping delivery.
- The parking issues continue to be mentioned to the board and we continue to send E-mails. The Board would appreciate everyone's cooperation. Please help make this a harmonious place to live and avoid the need for the Board to issue fines.

IRRIGATION SYSTEMS

For those with irrigation systems, it's time to test the backflow prevention valve. This is an annual test required by the City of Lee's Summit and has to be conducted by a licensed technician.
