NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH

School will begin in a few weeks. It's a good time to remind your children about child abduction prevention. Below are some important statistics:

- Most abducted children are taken by family members, family friends or acquaintances of the child.
- Most children were taken by adults they had been taught to trust. Recent statistics reported only 115 of 258,000 abducted children were taken by strangers.
- Though stranger abductions are rare, it's still important to know the risk factors and teach your children how to defend themselves.
- The average victim is female, 10-14 years of age, walking to or from school/school activity. Victims usually escape by walking or running without any physical contact with the perpetrator.

They may not recognize a stranger as "dangerous" if the person is nice, pretty, clean-shaven, smiling, etc. Set clear boundaries with your children regarding what times they are allowed to talk to strangers (only when an adult of your choosing is present) and the type of information that is ok to discuss. Explain the difference between a safe stranger (police officer, fire fighter, teacher) and a stranger you don't trust. Point out strangers while you're in public so your child will learn the concept. Teach them to run away if a stranger approaches, and reassure them that they will not get in trouble for being assertive with a stranger who makes them uncomfortable.
