GEORGIAN DRIVE TRAFFIC STUDY

The Board has requested the City conduct another traffic study on Georgian Drive. Speeding has been a safety hazard for many years. Studies conducted in 2012 & 2017 failed to recommend physical improvements to improve the situation. Such improvements were not an option at the time but are now available. The petition being circulated by Block captains requires signature of 50% of all homeowners for the City to conduct the study. The Board supports the study and encourages you to sign the petition. Results that recommend physical improvements must receive 75% approval (a second petition) to install.
